



Second Qualifying Round Draw 5th UEFA European Women's Under-17 Championship 2011/12

DRAW PROCEDURE

15 November 2011, Nyon / Switzerland

Qualified Teams

The following teams have qualified for the second qualifying round:

- Germany and the Netherlands (as seeded teams automatically qualified for the second qualifying round)
- The 10 group winners and the 4 best runners-up

Coefficient Ranking List

In order to divide the 16 teams into **4 pots**, the following principles have been applied.

The 16 qualified teams have been ranked, taking into account the results of the first qualifying round, i.e. win = 3 points, draw = 1 point, defeat = 0 points (see enclosed coefficient ranking list).

Distribution of the Teams

The 16 teams have been split into four pots as follows:

Pot A	• Teams ranked in positions 1 – 4	4 purple balls
Pot B	• Teams ranked in positions 5 – 8	4 blue balls
Pot C	• Teams ranked in positions 9 – 12	4 yellow balls
Pot D	• Teams ranked in positions 13 – 16	4 red balls

Draw Procedure

The 16 associations will be drawn into 4 groups of 4 teams according to the following procedure:

1st Draw phase

- The teams in **Pot A** will be drawn one after the other into **first** position in Groups 1 to 4 (in numerical order).

2nd Draw phase

- The teams in **Pot B** will be drawn one after the other into **second** position in Groups 1 to 4 (in numerical order).

3rd Draw phase

- The teams in **Pot C** will be drawn one after the other into **third** position in Groups 1 to 4 (in numerical order).

4th Draw phase

- The teams in **Pot D** will be drawn one after the other into **fourth** position in one of the 4 groups.

- The teams will be allocated to a group in such a way as to ensure that no team will meet another team which it has already played in the first qualifying round. Consequently,

- If clashes arise with a group winner, the team drawn is moved to the next available group, following in numerical order.
- In case of potential clashes in the last two or three groups, there will be no draw and the teams will be allocated to their respective groups accordingly.

Dates and Host

Matches in the second qualifying round must be played by mid-April 2012.

The four teams in each group must decide on the host and dates immediately after the draw. For this purpose, a meeting area will be made available where the four teams can meet and discuss this matter.

Qualification for the Final Round

The four group winners will qualify for the final round, which will take place in Nyon from 26 to 29 June 2012.
