



## **Second Qualifying Round Draw** **5<sup>th</sup> UEFA European Women's Under-17 Championship 2011/12**

### **DRAW PROCEDURE**

**15 November 2011, Nyon / Switzerland**

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#### **Qualified Teams**

The following teams have qualified for the second qualifying round:

- Germany and the Netherlands (as seeded teams automatically qualified for the second qualifying round)
- The 10 group winners and the 4 best runners-up

#### **Coefficient Ranking List**

In order to divide the 16 teams into **4 pots**, the following principles have been applied.

The 16 qualified teams have been ranked, taking into account the results of the first qualifying round, i.e. win = 3 points, draw = 1 point, defeat = 0 points (see enclosed coefficient ranking list).

### **Distribution of the Teams**

The 16 teams have been split into four pots as follows:

<b>Pot A</b>	• Teams ranked in positions 1 – 4	<b>4 purple balls</b>
<b>Pot B</b>	• Teams ranked in positions 5 – 8	<b>4 blue balls</b>
<b>Pot C</b>	• Teams ranked in positions 9 – 12	<b>4 yellow balls</b>
<b>Pot D</b>	• Teams ranked in positions 13 – 16	<b>4 red balls</b>

### **Draw Procedure**

The 16 associations will be drawn into 4 groups of 4 teams according to the following procedure:

#### *1<sup>st</sup> Draw phase*

- The teams in **Pot A** will be drawn one after the other into **first** position in Groups 1 to 4 (in numerical order).

#### *2<sup>nd</sup> Draw phase*

- The teams in **Pot B** will be drawn one after the other into **second** position in Groups 1 to 4 (in numerical order).

#### *3<sup>rd</sup> Draw phase*

- The teams in **Pot C** will be drawn one after the other into **third** position in Groups 1 to 4 (in numerical order).

#### *4<sup>th</sup> Draw phase*

- The teams in **Pot D** will be drawn one after the other into **fourth** position in one of the 4 groups.
- The teams will be allocated to a group in such a way as to ensure that no team will meet another team which it has already played in the first qualifying round. Consequently,
  - If clashes arise with a group winner, the team drawn is moved to the next available group, following in numerical order.
  - In case of potential clashes in the last two or three groups, there will be no draw and the teams will be allocated to their respective groups accordingly.

### **Dates and Host**

Matches in the second qualifying round must be played by mid-April 2012.

The four teams in each group must decide on the host and dates immediately after the draw. For this purpose, a meeting area will be made available where the four teams can meet and discuss this matter.

### **Qualification for the Final Round**

The four group winners will qualify for the final round, which will take place in Nyon from 26 to 29 June 2012.
