

USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR ACCREDITATION

Accreditation Passes

Tournament Pass

A Tournament Pass is valid until 4 days after the last match in the relevant stadium(s), including Match Days. Exceptions:

- In the IBC, this pass is valid between 1 May and 19 July 2012;
- Non-Rights Holders Tournament Passes are not valid on Match Days (as indicated on the pass).

Two-Part Pass

A Two-Part Pass has the same validity as a Tournament Pass.

It consists of:

- a Personalised Card which displays the Information of the pass holder (e.g. photo) and the organisation information;
- an Access Card, i.e. a smaller card which displays the organisation information and access entitlements.

Unlike the Personalised Card the Access Card has been distributed to the contact person of the organisation. The Personalised Card alone allows access to the stadium on Non-Match Days. Access on Match Day is only granted if the person holds both parts of the Two-Part Pass!

Day Pass

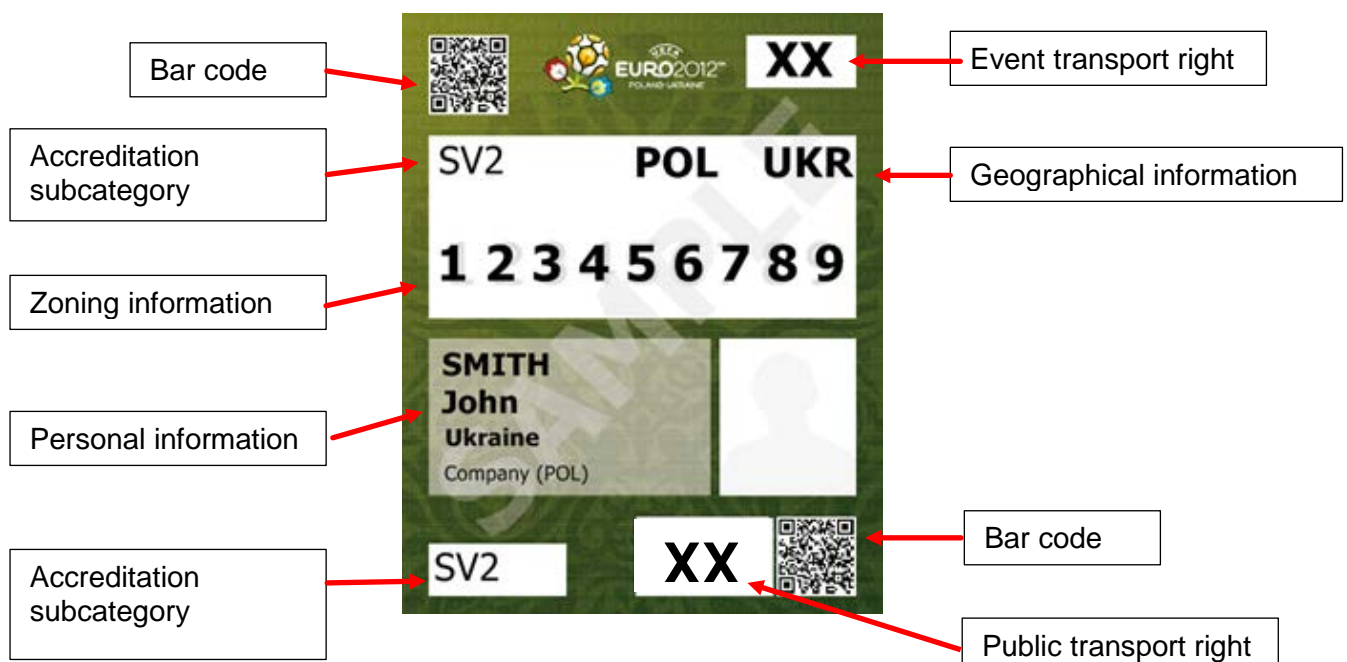
A Day Pass is valid for ONE day and ONE venue only.

Setup Pass

A Setup Pass is valid on Non-Match Days ONLY.

Access Rights

The codes and numbers on your Accreditation Pass indicate the venue(s) and zone(s) to which you have access to.



Geographical Information

A 3-letter code is printed on the Accreditation Pass to identify in which venues the device is valid:

Note: access to the IBC is granted if the pass has (at least) "IBC" or "POL" or "POL UKR" as geographical information.

Zoning Information

Each stadium is divided into nine zones on match days. Please find the zoning description on the backside of your Accreditation pass.

In the IBC there are only two zones defined: 3 and 8.

Accreditation Category

The category you are assigned to is displayed by the colour on the pass. The subcategory by the code made up of letters or letters and numbers.

SADs - Supplementary Access Devices

On Match Days, as of 3 hours prior to kick-off, certain zones can only be accessed with a valid Accreditation Pass and the relevant SAD. SADs are impersonalised accreditation devices which can come in the form of a bib, a bib card, an SAD card or a wristband.

Collecting your SADs

Media:

- SADs for Photographers are distributed on Match Day in the Stadium Media Centre as of 3 hours before the kick-off according to the priority lists;
- Non-Broadcast Media collect SADs on Match Day at the Stadium Media Centre during its opening hours;
- Broadcasters on Match Day -1 and Match Days in the TV Compound (Broadcast Partners and Host Broadcaster).

Non-Media:

- SADs are distributed to the contact person of the relevant organisation. Please contact your company representative.

When entering the venue there will be a visual control of your accreditation pass and a RFID scan of your accreditation pass on Match Day. As an accreditation pass holder you submit to possible body search and searches of your personal belongings. Furthermore you might be asked to produce a valid national identity card or passport!

Lost / Stolen Accreditation Devices

Must be reported to the Accreditation Centre. The issuance of a new accreditation pass is subject to a case-by-case decision and a payment of an administrative fee of EUR150 / PLN 600 / UAH 1500.
