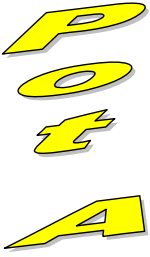
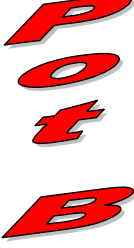
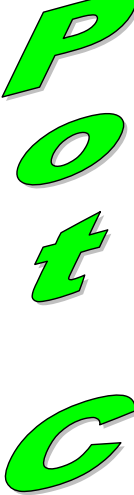

Qualifying Round(s):

- All qualifying round matches have been taken into consideration for all seasons.
- Teams eliminated in the first qualifying round = results of the first qualifying round have been taken into consideration.
- Participating teams in the second qualifying round = results of the first & second qualifying rounds have been taken into consideration.

Match points; Victory = 3 points; Draw = 1 point; Defeat = 0 point

Bonus points:

- Qualification to second qualifying round (incl. seeded teams) = 3 points
- Qualification to the final round = 3 points
- European Champions = 3 additional bonus points i.e. Germany (WU17 2007/08 & 2008/09), Spain (WU17 2009/10)

The coefficient for each season has been calculated by taking the number of points obtained (including bonus points) and dividing it by the number of matches. The three annual coefficients have then been added together to produce the overall coefficient used for the ranking list.

Associations with the same overall coefficient have been separated according to the following criteria:

- 1) Higher number of matches
- 2) Higher coefficient for the 2009/10 season
- 3) Higher coefficient for the 2008/09 season
- 4) Higher coefficient for the 2007/08 season
- 5) Superior goal difference for the 2009/10 season
