### **THE NEW UEFA WOMEN'S EURO TROPHY**

The UEFA Women's EURO logo inspired the shape and form for the competition trophy.

The flowing lines and motion of the logo's graphic icon, provided the Italian sculptor the visual means to interpret the spirit of the competition with a contemporary design - combining traditional craftsmanship with state-of-the-art computer aided manufacturing.

Milan-based G.D.E. Bertoni has provided the trophy for UEFA's flagship women's international competition, which was proudly unveiled in Manchester at the draw for the final tournament on 19 January 2005.

In 2001, Germany got to keep the previous trophy, having won the UEFA European Women's Championship for the third consecutive time.
