JUST FOLLOW THE GUIDES!

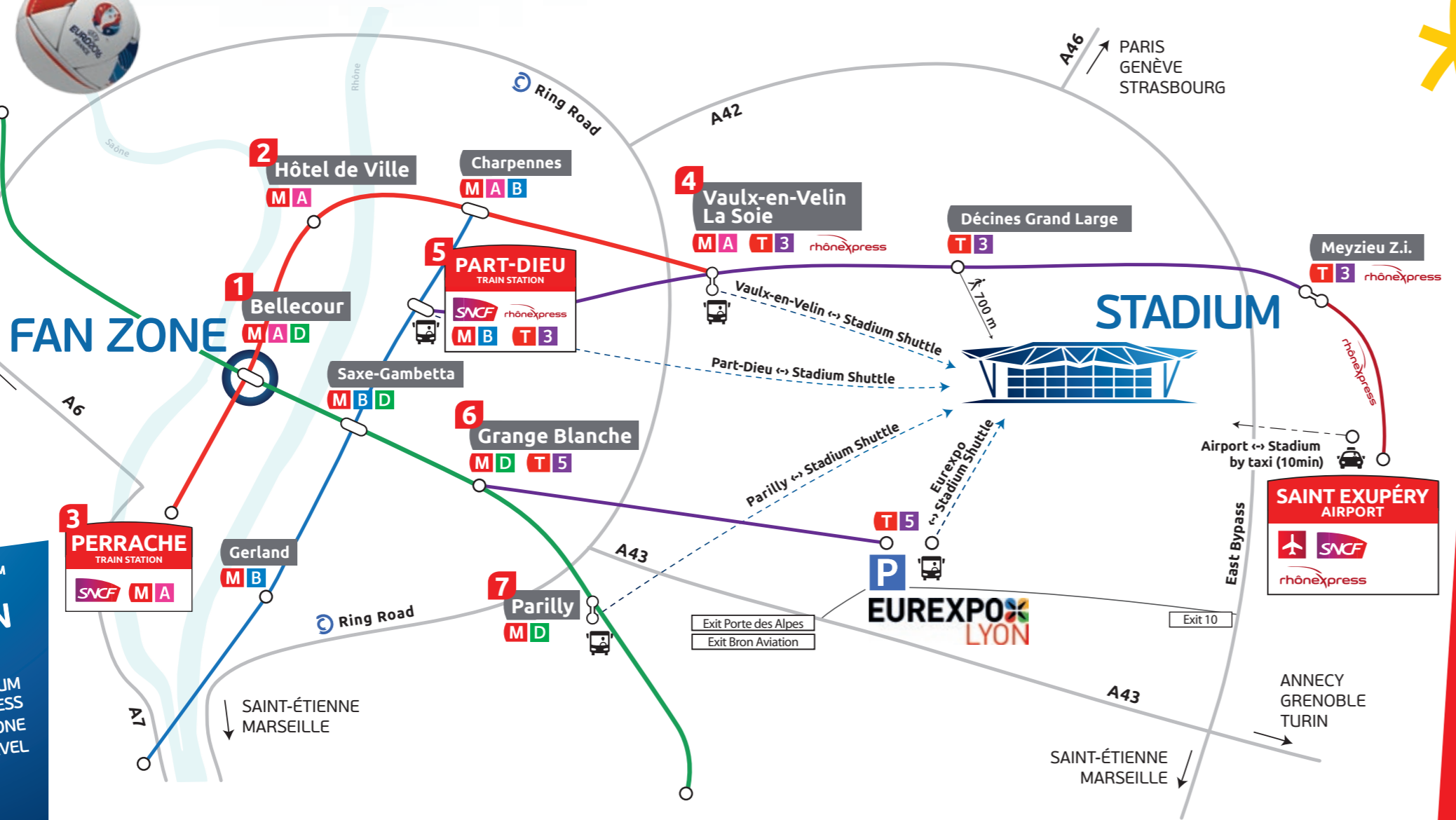
At these stations, welcome guides will indicate the most appropriate type of transportation for getting to the stadium. A shuttle service will be implemented 3.5 hours before the start of the match. To arrive at the proper time, leave as early as possible (at least two hours before the match starts).

YOU CAN TAKE A TAXI OR THE RHÔNEXPRESS SHUTTLE

> stop at Meyzieu Z.I., then take the T3 tramway to the Décines Grand Large stop located 700 m from the stadium.

IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO PARK IN THE VICINITY OF THE STADIUM. The Eurexpo parking lot, which is located 5 km south of the stadium and holds 6,000 cars, will be available during the UEFA EURO 2016. From there, a shuttle will take you to the stadium in less than 15 minutes.

TO ACCESS THE EUREXPO PARKING LOT, follow the "Eurexpo" signs

The parking lot will be open 4 hours before the start of the match.

From Lyon or the Ring Road > turn onto the A43 highway
 from the A43 highway > exit at Porte des Alpes or Bron Aviation
 From the East Bypass > exit 10

MEET AT THE FAN ZONE!

VIBRATE TO THE UEFA EURO 2016 IN THE HEART OF LYON. The Fan Zone is found on Bellecour Square, in the center of Lyon (Metro A D, Bellecour Station).

You can see a direct broadcast of all matches there. You will also find a beverage and snack area, along with a program of activities.

The Fan Zone is open on match days from noon to midnight. Glass bottles are prohibited inside the Fan Zone.

Supporters of teams playing in Lyon will find their Fans' Embassy near the Fan Zone, at the ONLY LYON Tourism Pavilion on Bellecour Square.

VIEUX LYON AND FOURVIÈRE HILL

This Renaissance-style neighborhood listed as a heritage site by UNESCO can be reached easily on foot from the Fan Zone. Stroll through its paved streets, courtyards and famous "traboule" alleyways 1. Discover its museums, in particular the Gadagne Museum 2 and the "Divinely Football!" exhibition. Fourvière Basilica 3, rises on Fourvière Hill, offering one of the most beautiful points of view over Lyon.



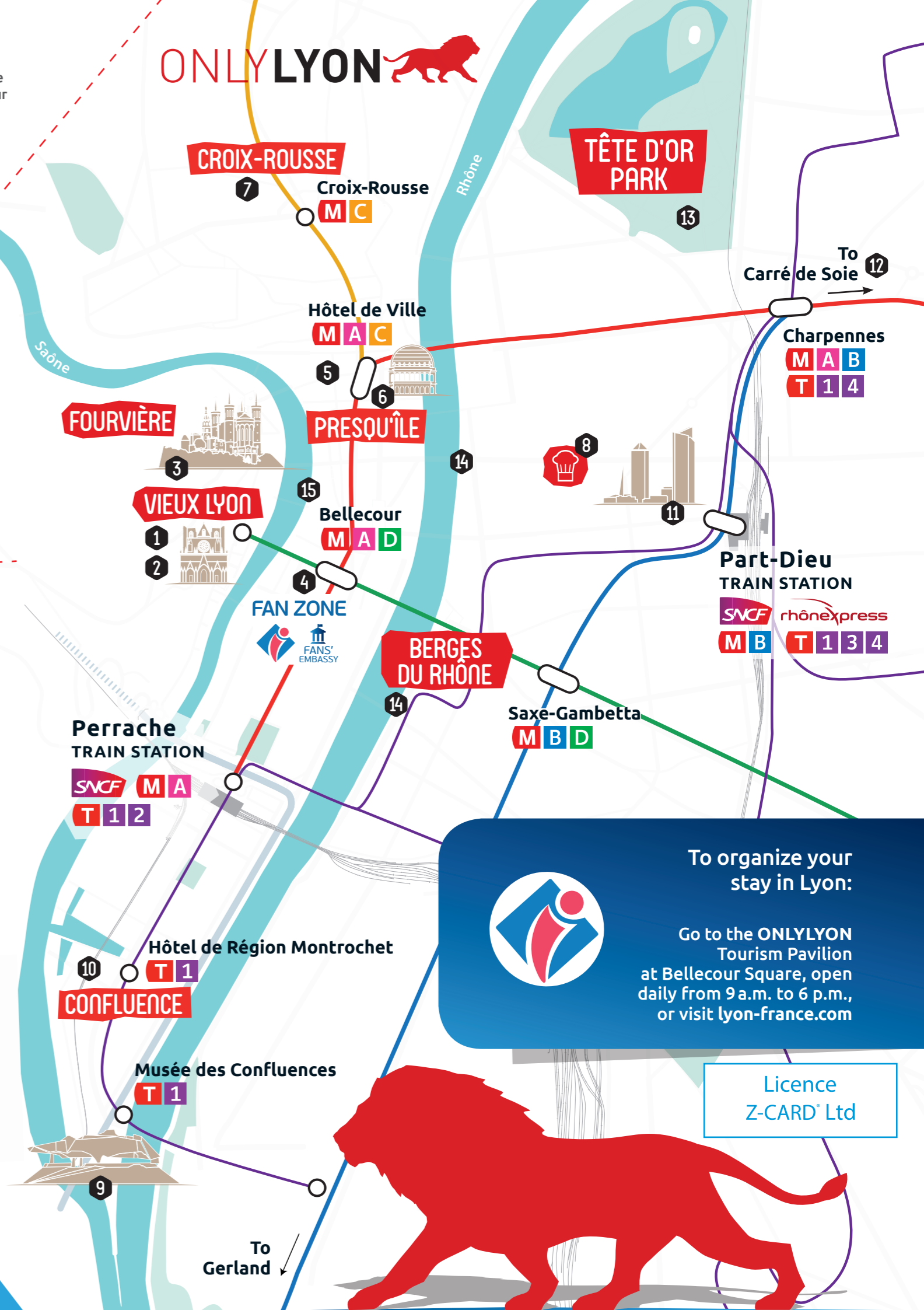
THE PRESQU'ÎLE

The Presqu'île between the Rhône and Saône rivers is the city center! Emblematic Bellecour Square 4, where the Fan Zone is located, is the starting point for discovering Lyon and enjoying the city's highlights (restaurants, bars, shops, museums, etc.). Visit Célestins Square, the Jacobins Fountain, Rue de la République, Place des Terreaux 5, the Museum of Fine Arts or the Opera designed by Jean Nouvel 6.

WHAT YOU MUSTN'T MISS IN LYON

CROIX-ROUSSE

The former home of the Canuts, who were silk workers, Croix-Rousse looks like a village. A superb panorama is yours at the end of the plateau 7. As you descend, don't miss the mural with the famous faces of Lyon, including the Lumière brothers, Abbé Pierre, Paul Bocuse and Saint-Exupéry.



GASTRONOMY

Welcome to Lyon, the capital of gastronomy! Enter a typical Lyon restaurant (known as a "bouchon") and sample Lyon pork sausage (la rosette), quenelles and praline tart, accompanied with a regional wine. Before leaving Lyon, stock up on local specialties at the covered market in Halles de Lyon Paul Bocuse 8.



CONFLUENCE

This district forms a bold, ultramodern complex that is home to Lyon's newest museum: the Musée des Confluences 9, an imposing glass and metal cloud that floats over the confluence of the Rhône and Saône.



BERGES DU RHÔNE AND RIVES DE SAÔNE

Ideal for lazy afternoons, these riverbanks have been designed for walking along the water's edge. The Rhône banks 14 invite you to stop on the terrace of a barge and have a drink or dinner or listen to a concert. The wilder Saône riverbanks 15, promise an escapade accented with works of art and pretty panoramas of the city. Over 30 km to enjoy on foot or by bike!



TÊTE D'OR PARK

Tête d'Or Park 13 is a peaceful haven in the heart of Lyon, with 105 hectares of greenery, a zoo, greenhouses and a rose garden. A great place to enjoy a walk, a break or a picnic, the park is a favorite spot for sports fans and families!



SHOPPING

At Presqu'île, you'll find the leading fashion and home decoration brands, along with designer boutiques. The Confluence 10, Part-Dieu 11 and Carré de Soie 12 districts are the sites of the main shopping centers, with hundreds of shops over several levels.
