UEFA Women's EURO 2009 play-off draw

Ten teams will get a second chance to qualify

The play-off draw for the Final Tournament of UEFA Women's EURO 2009 will take place at the House of European Football in Nyon, Switzerland, on 6 October 2008 at 12:00 CET.

The six group runners-up and four best third-placed teams from the qualifying competition will enter the draw to determine the fixtures of the play-off matches. The remaining matches in the qualifying competition will be played on 1 and 2 October.

The play-off matches will be played under the home-and-away system on 25/26 and 29/30 October, and the five winners of those ties will be joining the hosts Finland and the six group winners of the qualifying stage for the final tournament taking place from 23 August to 10 September 2009.

The Finnish team will play three group-matches in the Olympic Stadium of Helsinki, which will host one more group-match and the final of 10 September. The Helsinki Football Stadium, Tampere Stadium, Turku Stadium and Lahti Stadium are the other venues selected to host UEFA Women's EURO 2009 final tournament matches.

The detailed match schedule for the final tournament will be announced after the final draw, which is going to take place at the Finlandia Hall in Helsinki on 18 November.
