## ***UEFA Executive Committee agenda for Nyon meeting***

### **Media accreditation deadline is Monday 14 September**

The UEFA Executive Committee, chaired by UEFA President Michel Platini, will hold its next meeting at the House of European Football, in Nyon, Switzerland, during the afternoon of Monday 14 September and the morning of Tuesday 15 September 2009.

The meeting is scheduled to take place from 14:00 to 17:00 on 14 September and from 09:00 to 12:00 on 15 September. It will be followed by a press conference at approximately 12:15 in the same location.

The main points on the agenda are:

- Financial fair play – Approval of recommendations and establishment of Club Financial Control Panel
- Regulations of the UEFA European Football Championship 2010-12
- UEFA EURO 2012 draw procedure
- Approval of new associations to the UEFA Referees Convention
- Grassroots Charter: membership approval
- Report on the 2009 UEFA European Under-21 Championship final round in Sweden and the UEFA WOMEN'S EURO 2009 in Finland
- 2009/10 UEFA European Futsal Championship: draw procedure for the final round in Hungary
