Agenda announced for UEFA Executive Committee meeting in Madeira

Decision on designation of UEFA EURO 2012™ host cities in Ukraine

The agenda for the last UEFA Executive Committee meeting of 2009 has today been announced.

Chaired by UEFA President Michel Platini, the UEFA Executive Committee meeting will take place in Funchal, Madeira Island, Portugal, during the afternoon of Thursday 10 and the morning of Friday 11 December 2009.

The main item for decision on the agenda is the designation of the remaining host cities to join Kyiv in Ukraine for UEFA EURO 2012™. A decision will also be taken on the venue for the final itself.

Other items on the agenda include:

- a progress report on Financial Fair Play
- an update on UEFA's Betting Fraud Detection System, and on the recent events
- approval of the establishment of UEFA's new commercial company
- approval of the programme and agenda for the XXXIV Ordinary UEFA Congress in Tel Aviv, on 25 March 2010.

The Executive Committee meeting will be held at Reid's Palace Hotel, Estrada Monumental 139, 9000-098 Funchal, and will be followed by a press conference at approximately 12:15 local time on Friday 11 December.
