UEFA announces UEFA Champions League agreement with Eurosport

Deal for Pan-European delayed coverage and archive

UEFA today announced an agreement with Eurosport, in principle for one season, with an option for a further two seasons, for archive and delayed Pan-European UEFA Champions League rights.

Eurosport, the leading Pan-European sports network, has acquired the right to show delayed games of at least 60 minutes duration after Thursday 24:00 CET as well as highlights after Sunday 24:00 CET each matchweek.

In addition, one archive game will be shown before Tuesday 20:00 on any matchweek and Eurosport will also have the right to feature 8 "Classics" programmes over the season, which will include archive material.

Eurosport is 100% owned by TF1 Group, another broadcast partner of the UEFA Champions League.

Commenting on the deal, UEFA CEO Gerhard Aigner, said:

"The renewal of UEFA's deal with Eurosport, together with Eurosport's ongoing commitment to UEFA's youth and women's competitions, shows the broadcaster's dedication to the best of European football and ensures maximum exposure for the UEFA Champions League."
