## AS Roma to play two matches behind closed doors

The UEFA Control and Disciplinary Body today announced their decision regarding the sanctions to be imposed on AS Roma following the incidents after their UEFA Champions League Group B match against FC Dynamo Kyiv on 15 September 2004 in the Olimpico stadium, Rome.

The Control and Disciplinary Body has decided to award a 0-3 forfeit victory to Dynmao Kyiv and has ordered AS Roma to play its next two home club competitions matches behind closed doors. This concerns the UEFA Champions League Group B matches, against Bayer 04 Leverkusen on 03 November and against Real Madrid CF on 08 December.

In taking the decision the Control and Disciplinary Body took into account the seriousness of the nature of the incident, in which the referee Anders Frisk was injured and therefore led him to abandon the match.

In addition, the AS Roma player Philippe Mexes has been suspended for 2 matches for particularly unsporting conduct.

Any appeal against the decisions of the UEFA Control and Disciplinary Body must be made by Friday 24 September 24.00 CET at the latest.
