UEFA EURO 2008™ final-round draw on 2 December in Lucerne – Information on event programme

Nyon – The final draw for UEFA EURO 2008™ is taking place this Sunday, 2 December 2007, in Lucerne. Starting at 12.00, the 16 qualifying nations will be drawn into four groups and musical interludes will be provided by Spanish star tenor José Carreras and by the Vienna Boys' Choir.

The running theme of the 52-minute programme is "Football meets classical music". In addition to José Carreras and the Vienna Boys' Choir, there will be performances by the Berne Bach Choir, the ORF Orchestra and Swiss alphorn player Eliana Burki. Another item on the agenda is the presentation of the official UEFA EURO 2008™ match ball. Swiss actress Melanie Winiger and Rainer Pariasek, TV presenter on Austria's ORF, will guide viewers and guests through the programme.

The draw is being held at the Culture and Convention Centre in Lucerne, on the shores of Lake Lucerne. The centre was designed by architect Jean Nouvel and is one of the landmarks of modern-day Switzerland.
