

Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) Procedure

Procedure for players who need to take a prohibited substance for medical reasons.

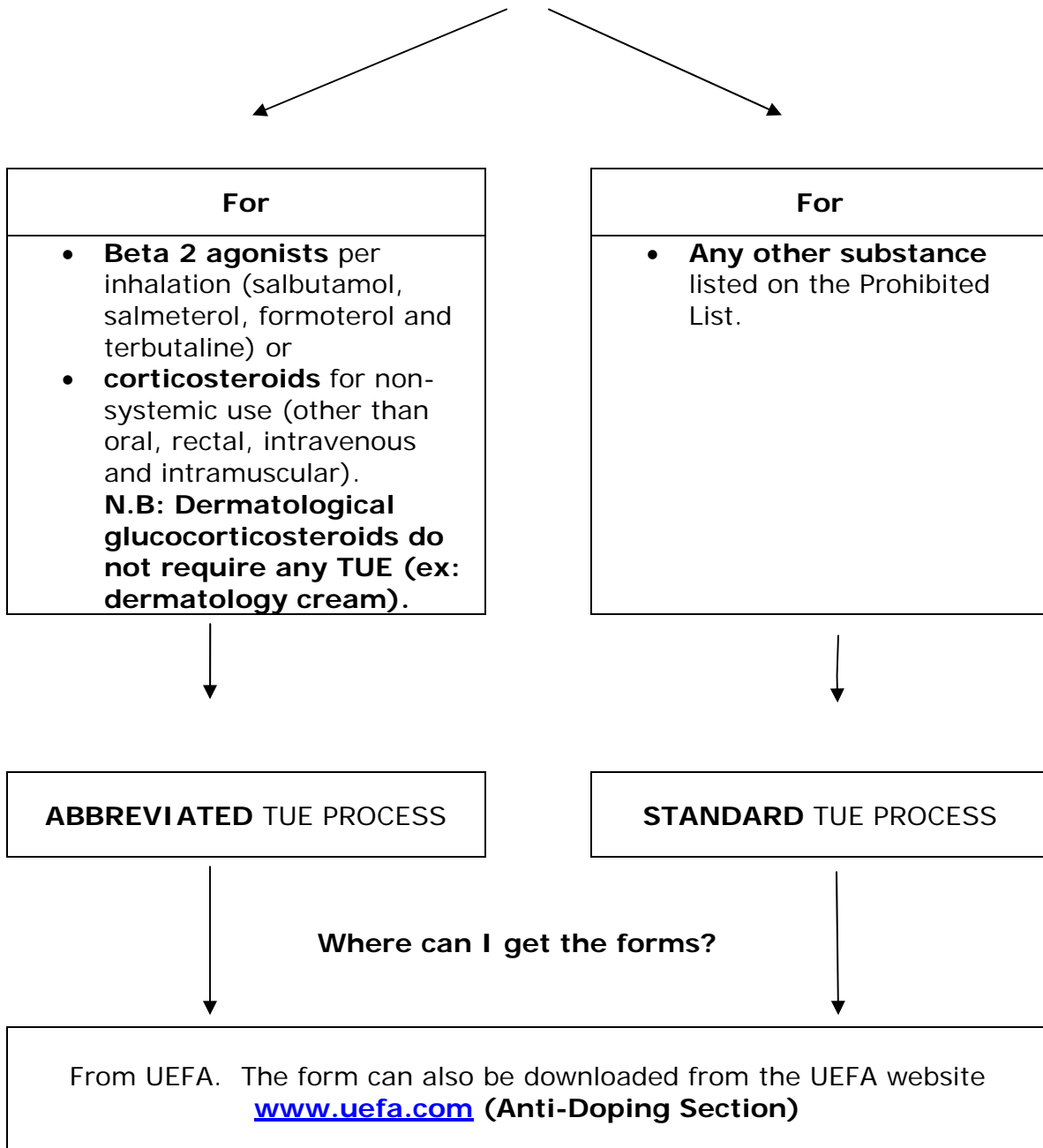
Please note :

- The TUE request forms must be filled in **typed**, if possible, or written in **block capitals**.
- The TUE must be completed in English, German or French. If the medical information attached is in another language, please enclose a summary in English, German or French.
- Any TUE request that is **not complete or illegible** will not be dealt with and will be returned to the player, who will need to submit it again.
- The player can only submit one TUE request to one instance at a time. He/she is not allowed to submit the same TUE request to several instances. If your National anti-doping organisation has already granted you a TUE, you do not need to submit the same TUE request to UEFA since it will recognize the TUE if it is in conformity with the WADA International Standards.
- Keep a copy of the certificate (TUE) or acknowledgement of receipt from UEFA and, it is not mandatory but advised, to present it and/or declare the TUE and prohibited substance(s) concerned at the doping control.
- This procedure should not in any case hinder or differ the implementation of a necessary medical treatment.

Compliance with sports rules

If I need to take a medicine that is listed on the Prohibited List, I must follow the procedure explained below as soon as possible:

How to fill in the form?

Abbreviated TUE

Standard TUE

Fill in the form in **block capitals** correctly and legibly with your doctor, who should complete the appropriate boxes.

Where to submit the form?

Keep a copy of the TUE form and the fax confirmation sheet.

**When am I allowed to take
the prohibited substance?**

Abbreviated Request

Standard Request

As soon as the request form is received by UEFA, the player is authorized to take the requested substance (unless special notification from UEFA).

Upon receipt of authorization from UEFA. The player is then authorized to use the substance in question in his sports practice. This authorization notice will specify the details of medical use, which will have to be duly respected.
