FC Dinamo 1948 București will look to avenge Matchday 3's 4-1 loss in Istanbul when they host Galatasaray AŞ for a third time, with a win for the Turkish side certain to net them a UEFA Europa League knockout phase place provided SK Sturm Graz do not beat Panathinaikos FC.

Previous meetings

- The clubs crossed paths in two previous two-legged ties, with the first – in the preliminary round of the 1956/57 European Champion Clubs' Cup – representing both teams' UEFA club competition debut.
- Angelo Niculescu's Dinamo won the first leg in Bucharest 3-1, with Gündüz Kılıç's Galatasaray prevailing in the return fixture 2-1. The teams for that opening game, on 26 August 1956, were:-

- Dinamo were eliminated by PFC CSKA Sofia – then named CDNA Sofia – in the next round.
- Kılıç's Galatasaray avenged that 1956 defeat in the same round of the 1962/63 competition, drawing 1-1 in Romania before seeing off Nicolae Nicușor Dumitru's charges 3-0 at home.
- The teams for the 1-1 draw on 9 September 1962 were:-

- Galatasaray went on to reach the quarter-finals, succumbing to eventual winners AC Milan.

Match background

- Including their two previous ties against Dinamo, Galatasaray have never won in Romania, recording a draw and four defeats in their five visits.
- Dinamo have played five games at home against Turkish sides, winning three and drawing the other two.
- Galatasaray are unbeaten in nine European fixtures this season.
- Dinamo are without a victory in their last six European home games since a 2-1 UEFA Cup group stage win against Bayer 04 Leverkusen on 29 November 2006 – a run that will stretch to three years if they fail to beat Galatasaray. They have failed to score in their last three European home ties.
- Galatasaray are unbeaten in nine European away games, but lost their previous fixture in Romania, 1-0 against FC Steaua București, in last season's UEFA Champions League third qualifying round on 27 August 2008.

Team facts

- Dinamo caretaker coach Ion Marin – who stepped up to replace Dario Bonetti when he was dismissed before Matchday 3 after just three months in the job – left to take a job in Saudi Arabia the day after the defeat by Galatasaray.
- Cornel Tălнар, a 52-year-old who spent eight successful years at the club (1977-1985) as a player, has been appointed for a third spell as interim coach after previous short stints in 1996-97 and 2007-08.
- Galatasaray coach Frank Rijkaard won friendly games against Romania as both a player (2-0 on 1 June 1988) and a coach (2-1 on 27 May 2000) with the Netherlands. He was also in the Milan side which beat Steaua 4-0 in the 1988/89 European Champion Clubs' Cup final.
- Dinamo's Gabriel Tamaș and Florin Bratu played for Galatasaray in the 2003/04 season.

- Galatasaray goalkeeper Leo Franco and Dinamo defender Francisco Molinero were team-mates at Club Atlético de Madrid from 2004 to 2006.
- The clubs share a famous former coach in Mircea Lucescu, who lifted last season's UEFA Cup trophy with FC Shakhtar Donetsk. The former Dinamo and Romania striker coached his old club from 1986 to 1990, winning both cup and league titles and reaching the semi-finals of the UEFA Cup Winners' Cup in 1990. He led Galatasaray from 2000 to 2002, bringing in the 2000 UEFA Super Cup and a domestic championship in 2001/02.
- Having scored twice in Group F, Milan Baroš is expected to miss the remainder of the group stage after breaking two metatarsal bones in his left foot during his side's 3-1 derby loss to Fenerbahçe SK on 25 October.
- This is not the only game between Romanian and Turkish sides on Matchday 4 as Fenerbahçe SK and Steaua will be locking horns in Group H.
- Galatasaray's Mustafa Sarp celebrates his 29th birthday on the day of the match.
- Galatasaray host Panathinaikos on Matchday 5, with Dinamo at home to Sturm on the same day, 3 December.

Competition information

The UEFA Cup evolved from the Inter-Cities Fairs Cup, and was first contested as the UEFA Cup in 1971/72. This season the UEFA Cup has been reborn as the UEFA Europa League. The new name heralds major changes to the competition, which has a new 48-team group stage with centralised marketing of broadcast rights, a presenting sponsor - Spanish car manufacturer SEAT - and an official matchball in addition to centralised sponsorship from the knockout stage and a new logo and visual identity.

• **Disciplinary information:** As a rule, a player who is sent off is suspended for the next match in a UEFA club competition. The Control and Disciplinary Body is entitled to augment this punishment. In the case of repeated cautions, from the group stage a player is suspended for one match after three cautions in three different matches, as well as following any subsequent odd-numbered caution (fifth, seventh, ninth, etc). Single yellow cards and pending suspensions are always carried forward either to the next stage of the competition or to another club competition in the current season.

• **Locally-trained players rule:** In February 2005, UEFA announced the 'A' list that teams submit for UEFA club competitions will continue to be limited to 25 players, and from the 2008/09 season at least eight places are reserved for players trained by the club's own football academy of which half can be players trained by other clubs from within the same association of the said club. The 'B' list also continues to exist – involving an unlimited number of Under-21 players who have been at the club for any uninterrupted period of two years since their 15th birthday.

A club-trained player is defined as a player who has been registered for a minimum of three seasons with the club between the age of 15 and 21, whereas an association-trained player is one who has been registered for at least three seasons by the club or by other clubs affiliated to the same association between the age of 15 and 21.

• **Away goals rule:** For matches played under the cup (knockout) system, the team which scores the greater aggregate of goals in the two matches qualifies for the next round. If the two teams involved in a tie score the same number of goals over the two legs, the team which scores more away goals qualifies for the next stage. If this procedure does not produce a result, i.e. if the two teams score the same number of goals at home and away, extra time of two periods of 15 minutes shall be played at the end of the second leg. If during extra time, both teams score the same number of goals, away goals count double (i.e. the visiting club qualifies). If no goals are scored during extra time, penalty kicks determine which team qualifies.

• **Player registration:** UEFA regulations state that for all UEFA Europa League matches from the start of the Round of 32, a club may register a maximum of three new eligible players within their squad of 25 for the remaining matches in the current competition. One player from the above quota of three who has played UEFA club competition matches for another competing club in the current season may exceptionally be registered, provided that the player has not been fielded by another club in the UEFA Europa League this season or by a club that has transferred from the UEFA Champions League to the UEFA Europa League following the group stage.

• **Assistant referees experiment:** The 144 UEFA Europa League group-stage games will be overseen by six match officials, in an experiment endorsed by the International Football Association Board (IFAB), with two additional assistant referees taking up positions alongside each goal. The additional assistant referees will provide two extra pairs of eyes to monitor the game, informing the referee of incidents that he may otherwise have missed.
