UEFA EURO 2012 team base camps presentation

Best accommodation for the teams during UEFA EURO 2012

Last week, the 53 UEFA member associations received the team base camps' catalogue containing the recommended UEFA EURO 2012 accommodation and training pitch for the national teams that qualify for the final tournament of the 2010–12 UEFA European Football Championship. The aim is to help them to choose a hotel and a training centre where the team will feel at home during their stay in Poland and Ukraine.

The team base camps are a great opportunity for all the regions represented in the catalogue to be in the spotlight, with the strongest teams in Europe and world-class footballers attracting a lot of fans and media to their tournament bases. It is therefore a great chance for these cities to become better known and to promote themselves.

The catalogue contains 38 possible team base camps, 21 in Poland and 17 in Ukraine. The local organising committees in Poland and Ukraine (EURO 2012 Polska Sp.z o.o. and LOC EURO 2012 Ukraine) already started the selection procedure at the beginning of 2008.

Key selection criteria:

- 4-5 star hotel or sport complexes.
- Sufficient number of rooms available.
- Privacy and amenities for long stay – gym, swimming pool, massage room, leisure areas, meeting rooms and private dining facilities.
- Training facilities should be close to the hotel and up to UEFA standards – at least one standard size natural pitch of top quality, with the possibility for both open and private training sessions.

Booking conditions:

- Hotels and training grounds can be visited between now and the final draw in December 2011 and can also be booked provisionally with UEFA.
- Each association can indicate a maximum of one preferred option and two waitlisted options per country.
- Bookings will be handled on a first come, first served basis.
- Bookings must be confirmed after the final draw.
- Hotels are not obliged to be at the exclusive disposal of the team in question.
- The association decides exactly how many rooms are required.
- Associations are not obliged to choose a base camp from the catalogue.

UEFA and the local organising committees recommend that the teams stay in the country where they will play their group matches, which is only known after the final draw in December 2011.

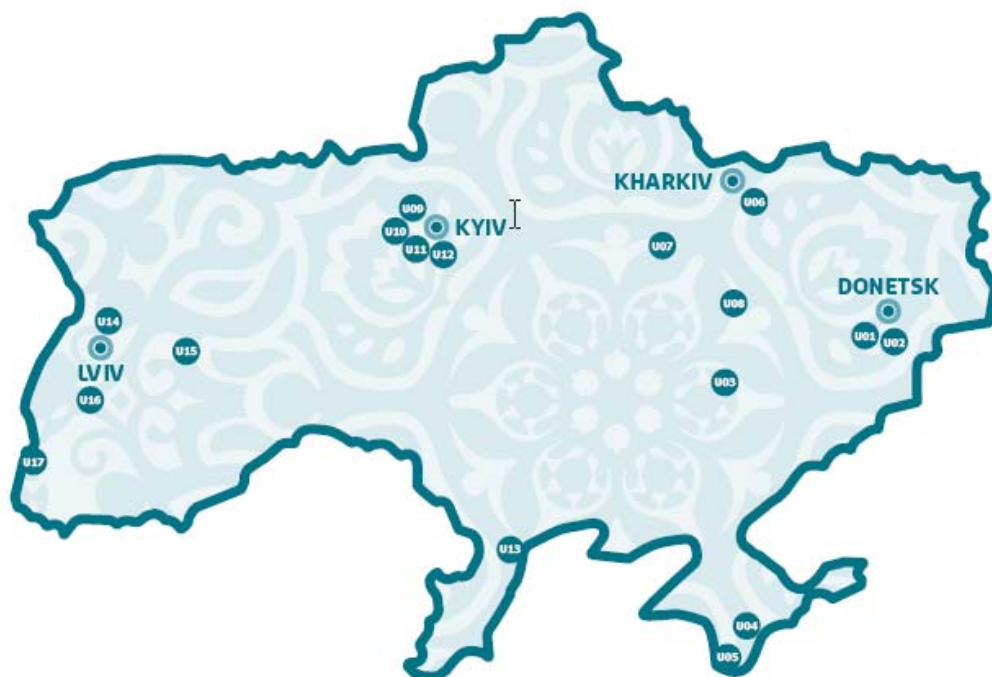
