The women's football committe in Gibrattar has become part of the heo women's football committee
football development committee. The Netherlands has a boord of supervisors and a board of directors for mateur foothall ret the Sweden is working on a review of its registration system. The figures
reported in 2017 are based on a survey that was sent to all local clubs. The number of players is isionificantly lower than peneviously reaported but closer to reality. Therefore, the decrease should be interpreted as a change in data accuracy and not as a real drop in the number of players
The English $F A$ has upgraded its data collection and reporting system and in doing so has undergone a data cleansing process to increase the accuracy of its team and player information. As a result of this process, a number of duplicate or invalid teams have been removed from the
statistics and the reported figures are lower than last season, despite nunderlying increase in particicapation in women's and girls' football in England.
Armenia and Romania have seen their registered player figures increase In school competitions and mass football programmes, which were not taken into account in previous years. Kosovo is not yet a member of the UEFA Coaching Convention and therefore cannot yet issue UEFA-endorsed licences.

Friendly matches:
Friendly matches: Matches that have no impact on the national tea ranking or qualification for an official UEFAFFFA tournament.
National academy: the opportunity by their national association to train together on a regular bass
(more than ten times a year).
Professional league: A league in which teams and players benefit financially and all income is generateded by footballing activities
Professional player: A player who has a contract with a club that is affiliated
to the national asociation to the national association via a league or a regional association. She is paid for
her footballing activities, and that payment covers all of her financial needs. Her her footadiling activites, and that payment covers all of her
last registration date was no more than 12 months ago.
Registered player: An individual who is registered with a national association
or an affiliated club, league or regional association and plays reaularly

regularly' means at least one official llub match or at least ten events

Semi-professional league: A league in which teams and players derive some neancial beneit in activities are in in some cases, not enough for them to live

Semi-professional player: A player who has a contract with a club that is affiliated to the national association via a league or a regional associatio
Payments made to her on account of her footballing activities cover the expenses she incurs, but are not enough for her to live on. Her last registration ate was no more than 12 months ago. achieving a common goal Women's football committee (or women's committee): A group of people pppointed or elected by the national association typically consisting of members
