## **8<sup>th</sup> UEFA European Under-19 Championship**

### **Media accreditation for final round to be held in Ukraine from 21 July to 2 August**

The draw for the final round of the 8<sup>th</sup> UEFA European Under-19 Championship was held last Friday in Donetsk, Ukraine, and was conducted by Grigoryi Surkis, President of the Ukrainian Football Federation and newly elected Chairman of the UEFA Youth and Amateur Football Committee, assisted by Oleksiy Mikhailichenko, former international player and current head coach of Ukraine national team.

The seven group winners from the elite round plus the host country, Ukraine, have been drawn into two groups of four, as follow:

All group phase matches and the two semi-finals will be played in four different stadiums in the cities of Donetsk (Centre A) and Mariupol (Centre B), with the final match to be played at Olimpiyskyi Stadium of Donetsk on Sunday 2 August. The final match schedule will be communicated by the end of this week on uefa.com.

Eurosport will broadcast live nine matches of the European Under-19 Championship final round, including the final and the semi-finals.
