UEFA Super Cup ticket sales launched

General public can apply for tickets on uefa.com as of today 12.00 hrs (CET)

UEFA has today launched the general public sales for the UEFA Super Cup 2010 to be held at 'Stade Louis II' in Monaco on Friday 27 August at 20:45 CET.

These tickets will be available to the neutral football fans who would like to attend the UEFA Super Cup match. Supporters of the two finalist clubs FC Internazionale Milano and Club Atlético de Madrid will be served via their clubs directly.

Interested fans can apply for tickets exclusively via www.uefa.com, from Monday 5 July starting at 12.00 hrs (CET) until Friday 16 July at 12.00 hrs (CET).

Tickets available for general public are Category 1 (Première) centrally located in the opposite main stand at a price of €70. The administrative fee is €5 per application. Payment can be made by credit card only.

Sales will be restricted to a maximum of two tickets per person and the applicants must accept the ticketing terms and conditions. Incorrect or incomplete applications will be rejected. All valid applications received during the above-mentioned period will go into a ballot if demand exceeds supply. Applicants will be informed until 22 July if they have been successful or not. The tickets will not be dispatched and they must be collected by the applicant from the Ticket Collection Point at the main entrance on 26 August from 10:00 to 18:00 or on 27 August from 10:00 to 18:00. The applicant should present a copy of the winner's confirmation email and also a valid ID document.

The net capacity of the Stade Louis II has been fixed at 18,000. A total of 75 per cent of the tickets are reserved for the general public and supporters of the two participating clubs.
