DRAW PROCEDURE

CROATIA 2012

Scenario: 42 teams (Croatia as Final Tournament host qualifies automatically)

PRELIMINARY ROUND

The 24 lowest ranked teams are drawn into 6 groups of 4 teams. These teams are drawn according to their coefficient ranking.

5 pots:

1. Hosts (6 teams)
2. Teams ranked 37 to 42, less hosts (4 teams)
3. Teams ranked 31 to 36, less host (5 teams)
4. Teams ranked 25 to 30, less host (5 teams)
5. Teams ranked 19 to 24, less hosts (4 teams)

QUALIFYING ROUND

6 teams qualify from the preliminary round, i.e. 6 group winners from the Preliminary Round, joining the top 18 teams in the rankings amounting to 24 teams in total in the qualifying round. The qualifying round consists of 6 groups of 4 teams which are drawn according to their coefficient ranking.

On the last matchday, all first matches in all groups must kick-off at the same time, as must all second matches.

The 6 group winners and 5 best runners-up qualify and join Croatia for the UEFA Futsal EURO to be played in February 2012 in Zagreb and Split.

5 pots:

1. Hosts (6 teams)
2. Winners of the Preliminary Round (6 teams)
3. Teams ranked 13 to 18, less hosts (4 teams)
4. Teams ranked 7 to 12, less hosts (3 teams)
5. Teams ranked 1 to 6, less host (5 teams)
