

In view of the current COVID-19 situation, all persons attending the 2020 UEFA Super Cup™ shall be required to comply with all sanitary measures and policies in place, including the requirement to:

- maintain social distancing of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible;
- wear a mask at all times* covering your nose and mouth whilst within the stadium perimeter;
- wash and disinfect hands whenever possible;
- undergo a body temperature check on entry to the stadium (if you have a temperature of 37.8°C or above you will not be permitted to enter the stadium);
- do not occupy any other seat, other than the one allocated as per your ticket;
- avoid shaking hands with others;
- avoid face to face contact with other spectators when moving to and from your seat;
- cough and sneeze into a tissue or into the crook of your arm;
- only eat and drink whilst in your seat;
- follow any and all instructions from stewards and officials in relation to sanitary and hygiene measures; and
- follow the directional signage and queuing systems in place at the stadium.

For the safety of everyone attending at the 2020 UEFA Super Cup™, anyone who fails to comply with the sanitary measures in place, and/or whose temperature measurement results in a reading which is outside of the permitted range, will not be allowed access to and/or will be ejected from the stadium.

**It is recommended that you bring additional masks with you to ensure that you are able to wear one at all times whilst at the stadium.*
