

Spectator's Code of Conduct

In order to assist our staff and stewards, and to help protect you and other football fans, you are kindly requested to follow these guidelines.

- Wear a mask at all times covering your nose and mouth whilst within the stadium perimeter. It is recommended that you bring additional masks with you to ensure that you are able to wear one at all times whilst at the stadium;
- Gates will open at 18:00 CEST. Arrive early to go through all the necessary procedures;
- make sure in advance that you know where your entry point is,
- make yourself familiar with the [stadium rules](#), sanitary measures and policies in place;
- maintain social distancing of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible;
- wash and disinfect hands whenever possible, use sanitizer stations when available;
- undergo a body temperature check on entry to the stadium (if you have a temperature of 37.8°C or above you will not be permitted to enter the stadium perimeter);
- do not occupy any other seat, other than the one allocated as per your ticket;
- avoid shaking hands with others, avoid hugs, high-fives and any close contact with others
- cough and sneeze into a tissue or into the crook of your arm;
- stay at your seat during half time and limit your movements to and from your seat to the full extent possible
- only eat and drink whilst in your seat;
- wear a mask and avoid face to face contact with other spectators when moving to and from your seat;
- if you do need to leave your seating position, wait for a time until the way is clear and always follow the signs indicating which way to go;
- follow the directional signage and queuing systems in place at the stadium;
- follow any and all instructions from stewards and officials in relation to sanitary and hygiene measures;
- if you are attending with other member of your “social bubble”, please make sure they have read and understood these guidelines too.
