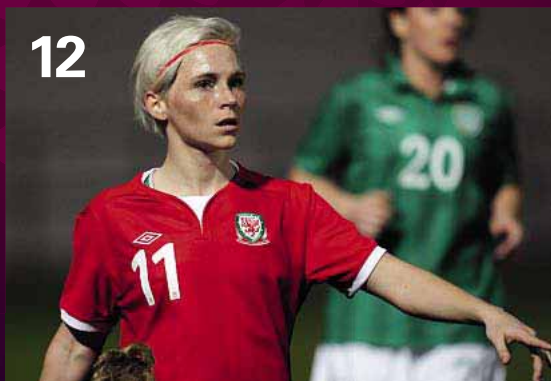

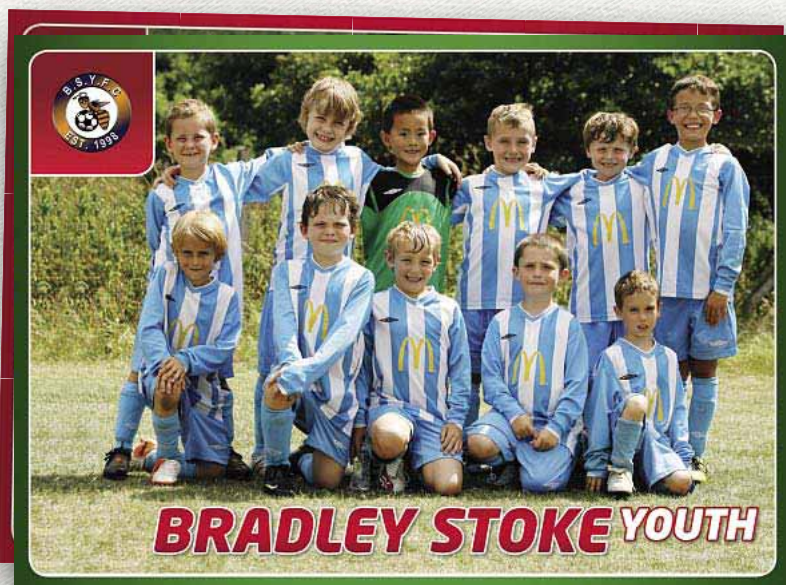

The Wales captain recalls her time with the Women's Under-19s

Mae capten Cymru yn hel atgofion am ei dyddiau gyda thîm Dan 19 Cymru

Jessica Fishlock is enjoying success abroad with Seattle Reign FC, but the 26-year-old says nothing can match the thrill of playing for her country, a passion she developed in the Welsh youth set-up.

What do you remember of your time with the WU19s?

I used to love being in the WU19s. I'm really happy we're hosting the final tournament but me and Gwen Harries always say we wish we were playing in it. My WU19 side got through to the second phase in Holland in 2005 and that was one of the best tournaments we had ever been in.

What advice would you give to the current WU19s on dealing with pressure at the finals?

It's going to be a new situation for all of them; they will be playing at home and up against big, big teams. They just need to enjoy the occasion and play the games as if they are normal internationals. Coach Jarmo Matikainen is very thorough in his homework on the opposition and just brings an aura of calmness and professionalism. He is nothing but great for us.

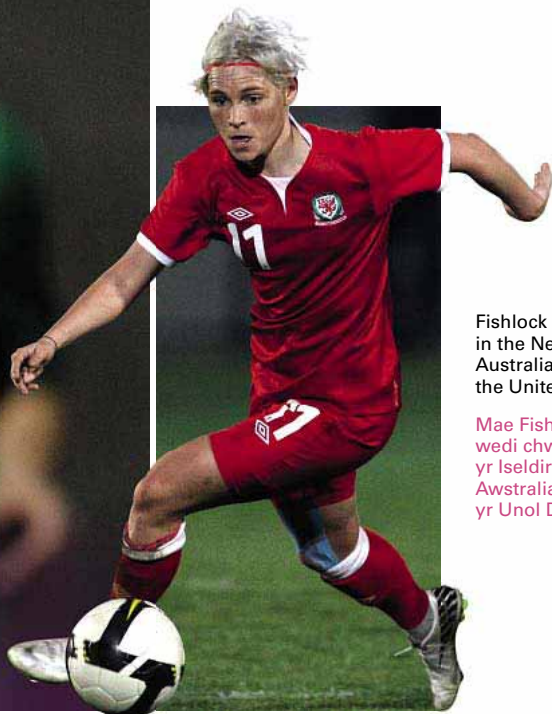
"I feel so privileged to put on the Welsh top"

Your career has taken you all over the world – did you ever imagine that would happen when you first started at Cardiff City LFC?

Absolutely not! I didn't realise this was going to be the path of my life but I'm extremely grateful that it is. I know how lucky I am. America is brilliant. I'm enjoying every minute of it – the professionalism of how it is run, and the challenge of competing with the best in the world.

What did it mean to you to pull on the Wales jersey for the first time?

Every time I put a Wales shirt on it feels like the first time. I feel so privileged to put on the Welsh top. It's just a feeling you don't get anywhere else or doing anything else.

The hosts are making their final tournament debut with their stock on the rise under Finnish coach Jarmo Matikainen. A 6-0 defeat by England ended their 2012 campaign but they drew with their neighbours in a friendly at the end of last year, winning a subsequent penalty shoot-out. With many players on senior duty, Wales have struggled to find fluency more recently, losing to Norway and WU19 holders Sweden. "The whole tournament is going to be tough, physically and mentally, but at the same time the team understand that they can still enjoy playing," Matikainen said. "Everyone at this level will have pressure, but to be able to perform and enjoy the tournament regardless is the most important thing."

Strike partner Camilla Andersen looked handy too, while Mie Jans, Stine Pedersen and Luna Gewitz all caught the eye in defence. "If you can call an Under-19 squad experienced, I would say that is what this side is, as many of these players also played the final tournament last year," said coach Søren Randa-Boldt. "Therefore, I am very optimistic as we go to Wales."

"Now this age group has made it to the final tournament we'd like to think there was more to come," Marley said. "We hope this is only the start."

France have not reached the Women's Under-19 final tournament since winning the competition for a second time in 2010, but have reason for optimism. Last October, Les Bleuettes lifted the FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup in Azerbaijan and much of that team has been promoted to the WU19 set-up. "They have been involved since the start of 2013 – I have really liked what I have seen," said coach Gilles Eyquem. A series of strong friendly performances preceded their assault on the second qualifying round, where they negotiated a potentially thorny group with some aplomb. With Kadidiatou Diani, Claire Lavogez and Léa Declercq all among the goals, they recorded victories against Belgium, Russia and Switzerland, scoring 11 and conceding only once.

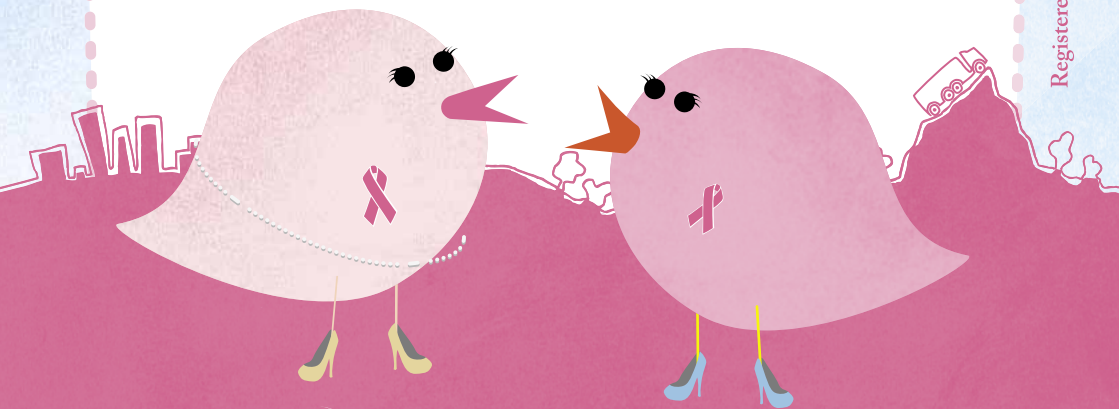

Russia goalkeeper Elvira Todua has never forgotten the thrill of winning the 2005 UEFA European Women's Under-19 Championship. "The emotions were just crazy," she said. "It still sends shivers down my spine when I remember it."

First contested as a WU18 tournament, Germany have led the field since its switch to WU19 level in 2002, claiming four titles, though France (2003, 2010), Spain (2004), Russia (2005), Italy (2008), England (2009) and Sweden (2012) have also engraved their names on the trophy. Moreover the final tournaments have flagged up talent from unexpected places. Just 16, Natasa Andonova starred in 2010 for hosts the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, in a tournament where a record 8,000 crowd attended the opening fixture in Skopje. Last summer in Turkey, Malin Diaz's goal in extra time handed Sweden the title. "I'm so proud," she said. "I can't believe we have done this." Those are sentiments that Todua, doubtless, will be familiar with.

Sweden made their breakthrough last season by becoming the seventh country to inscribe their name on the WU19 trophy and they return to defend the title in fine fettle. Calle Barrling's side edged a 1-0 victory over Spain in Turkey last summer and the scorer of that historic goal, Malin Diaz, is one of seven veterans of 2012 eligible in Wales. "It will not be easy because we will be compared to a championship-winning team," said Barrling. "However, it is a great advantage to have players who know what it takes to win a EURO." Qualifying was not easy this time out, but 17-year-old prospect Marija Banušić showed her potential with ten goals in six games.

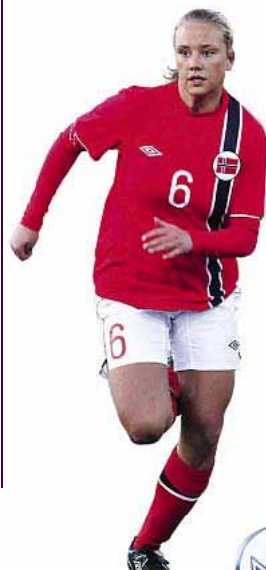

Welsh football is urging women to get involved

Mae byd pêl-droed Cymru yn annog merched i gymryd rhan

Wales will be looking to hold their own at the UEFA European Women's Under-19 Championship, but coach Jarmo Matikainen has bigger goals in mind as his team come under the spotlight. "My main concern is that there is a true legacy for women's football after the tournament," said the 53-year-old.

Hired by the Football Association of Wales (FAW) in October 2010, the former Finland boss oversees the WU17, WU19 and senior national teams as well as women's football development in Wales. One of his main concerns has been the FAW's Pro Wales Women's Top Football 2016 project, launched in December 2011 as part of UEFA's women's football development programme (WFDP). "UEFA's backing has been vital - it is essential," Matikainen said. "Without UEFA it would not have been possible."

Welsh masterplan

An all-encompassing long-term plan to raise standards in the Welsh game, the Top Football 2016 plan involves spreading knowledge, strengthening links between clubs and the national team, training and recruiting coaches and other support professionals, and giving opportunities for individuals to participate in the women's game at all levels.

"The main emphasis is on coaching, helping the coaches who are working day to day with our next generation of players,"

explained Matikainen. "I have been going around Wales and worked with the clubs; we have organised workshops, and that's the most rewarding thing in working as a coach."

The WU19 final tournament

can only help bring more attention to the women's game in Wales. "We need to increase awareness, show people how demanding the women's game is and to encourage

them to get involved," said the coach. "That's what we are working on with the FAW - to get as many young girls, parents and coaches in the stands and encourage everyone to get involved with the tournament"
