UEFA Executive Committee decisions Vaduz

Hosts appointed for club competition finals 2010

The UEFA Executive Committee met today in Vaduz, Liechtenstein, and has taken the following decisions.

At its meeting the UEFA Executive Committee:

- appointed the hosts for the finals of the UEFA club competitions in 2010 as follows:
 - UEFA Champions League Final 2010 – Santiago Bernabeu, Madrid
 - UEFA Cup Final 2010 – Hamburg Arena, Hamburg
 - UEFA Super Cup 2009/2010/2011 – Monaco

The UEFA Executive Committee decided to postpone the decision of the appointment of the hosts for the UEFA Champions League Final 2011 and UEFA Cup Final 2011 in order to allow more time for consideration of these bids.

- appointed the hosts for the final rounds of three youth competitions:
 - UEFA European Under-19 Championship 2010 – France
 - UEFA European Under-17 Championship 2010 – Liechtenstein
 - UEFA European Women's Under-17 Championship 2009 – UEFA (Nyon)
- approved guidelines on disputed goals for statistical purposes
- approved the regulations of several club competitions for 2008/09
- formally suspended the Football Association of Albania from all UEFA activities following a recent decision by FIFA

The next meeting of the UEFA Executive Committee is scheduled to be held in Moscow, Russia, on 19 and 20 May 2008, the day prior to the UEFA Champions League Final which takes place on 21 May at the Luzhniki Stadium in Moscow.
