UEFA Cup fourth round and quarter-finals draw

Draw to take place at UEFA Headquarters on 12 December 2001

The draw for the fourth round and the quarter-finals of the 2001/02 UEFA Cup will take place at UEFA's headquarters in Nyon on Wednesday, 12 December 2001 at 12:00 hours.

The sixteen clubs qualified for the fourth round have been seeded according to their individual club coefficients. Before Wednesday's draw the clubs will be split into two seeding pots, each containing four seeded and four unseeded clubs. The seeded clubs will be drawn against one of the unseeded clubs in their respective seeding pot.

For the quarter-final draw taking place immediately afterwards, no seedings will be used. This means that clubs from the same country may be drawn against each other.

Media representatives wishing to attend this event can get accreditation on site as from 10:00 on Wednesday morning. A sound system (split box) will be installed for ENG crews. Moreover, as there will be certain space restrictions, places will be allocated on a first-come first-served basis. However, we ask any media representatives wishing to attend the draw ceremony to kindly contact the Media Services via the above phone number. Parking facilities are available opposite the House of European Football, in front of the Colovray stadium.

Radio broadcasts from the auditorium will not be allowed. Reporters can follow the draw on the screens outside the auditorium if they prefer to report live and, immediately after the draw, make one-to-one interviews with club representatives.
