## ***EURO 2004™ Fair Play award handed over to Czech Republic***

### **Award to be presented to the head coach and team captain on Saturday**

UEFA will present the EURO 2004™ Fair Play award to the head coach of the Czech Republic Karel Bruckner and to the team captain prior to the kick-off of the FIFA World Cup qualifier to be played on Saturday 9 October at 17h00 against Romania at the Letná stadium in Prague.

UEFA Executive Committee member, Marios N. Lefkaritis of Cyprus, will be presenting the trophy to the Football Association of the Czech Republic on behalf of UEFA President Lennart Johansson.

The Czech Republic national team topped the UEFA EURO 2004™ Fair Play ranking with an average mark of 8.5 for five matches and showed true sportsmanship during the tournament in which they played attractive football and reached the semi-finals, only to lose to the future winners Greece.

The Fair Play ranking is based on criteria including players' behaviour, respect for opponents and referees, positive play as well as the conduct of supporters.
