Referee appointed for Wednesday's semi-final

The UEFA Referees Committee today announced the referee for the return leg of the semi-final tie in the 2006/07 UEFA Champions League between AC Milan and Manchester United FC, to be played on Wednesday 2 May at the Stadio Giuseppe Meazza in Milan, kicking-off at 20.45.

The match will be handled by 40-year-old Belgian referee Frank De Bleeckere. In Milan, he will be assisted by his compatriots Peter Hermans and Mark Simons, with Paul Allaerts acting as 4th Official.

Frank De Bleeckere's UEFA Champions League appearances this season have included the 1st Knock-Out Round confrontation between Real Madrid CF and FC Bayern München (3-2) at the Estadio Santiago Bernabéu.

The winner of this semi-final will, for administrative purposes, be considered the 'home' team for the final to be played at the Olympic Stadium in Athens on Wednesday 23 May.
