UEFA European Football Championship Mascot, 'KINAS', unveiled in Porto

UEFA and EURO 2004, SA, today launched the Official Mascot for the European Championship Final Tournament in Portugal next year. KINAS was unveiled by Dr. Gilberto Madaíl, President of the Portuguese Football Federation and Chairman of the Board of Euro 2004, S.A, at the Fundação de Serralves in Porto.

Created for UEFA EURO 2004[™] in close collaboration with colleagues in Portugal, KINAS is a likeable and enthusiastic personality who lives for football and demonstrates his love of the game's skills and fair play. The name Kinas is derived from a significant Portuguese symbol, the five shields in Portugal's coat of arms.
