## ***Draws for UEFA Champions League and UEFA Cup***

### **Draws for qualifying rounds to be held at UEFA's headquarters on Friday 20 June**

The first draws of the 2003/04 UEFA club competition season will take place on Friday 20 June. The pairings for the first two qualifying rounds of the UEFA Champions League and the qualifying round in the UEFA Cup will be made during ceremonies to be staged at UEFA's headquarters in Nyon, starting at 12.00 and 14.00 respectively.

Accreditation badges for media will be available as from 10.00 on the day of the draw at the media accreditation desk in the reception area at UEFA's headquarters. We kindly ask all media representatives wishing to attend these draws to apply to <mailto:accreditations@uefa.ch> before the evening of Wednesday 18 June.

Please note that due to the number of club representatives expected for the UEFA Cup draw, only photographers and a restricted number of ENG crews will be allowed to attend the draw in the auditorium, with access being granted on a first-come-first-served basis.

A sound system will be installed for ENG crews but no extra facilities such as telephone or ISDN lines will be available inside the draw hall and there are no special facilities for radio stations or websites. Due to interference problems, it is recommended for sound engineers not to use the following frequencies while in the House of European Football: 783.875 MHz, 786.125 MHz, 782.250 MHz, 782.875 MHz, 784.625 MHz, 785.250 MHz, 792.500 MHz, 794.875 MHz.

Both draws will be transmitted live on uefa.com.

Radio broadcasts from the auditorium are prohibited as is the use of mobile phones. Reporters can follow the draw on the screens outside the auditorium if they prefer to report live and, immediately after the draw, make one-to-one interviews with club representatives.

The media are kindly asked to use the car park opposite the House of European Football at the Colovray training centre. Moreover, media representatives are welcome to use the self-service part of UEFA's restaurant should they wish to have lunch there (at their own cost).

We looking forward to your company at the House of European Football as we kick-off the new UEFA club competition season.
