Match background

- Denmark won their opening game 1-0 against Belgium but then lost to the Netherlands by the same scoreline.
- Norway have lost 1-0 to the Netherlands and 2-0 to Belgium leaving them in danger of a first group exit since 1997, when they were co-hosts and reigning world champions.
- Norway have only twice failed to get out of the group stage in their 15 past major tournaments: EURO '97 and the 2011 FIFA Women's World Cup.
- These neighbours last met competitively in a memorable UEFA Women's EURO 2013 semi-final in Norrköping. Denmark had beaten France on penalties to reach the last four but Norway prevailed on spot kicks this time after a 1-1 draw.
- Mariann Gajhede Knudsen equalised three minutes from time for Denmark, who had fallen behind three minutes into the game to Marit Fiane Christensen's goal. Ingrid Hjelmseth saved two Danish penalties in the shoot-out.
- That was these teams' third UEFA Women's EURO semi-final meeting, Norway winning 1-0 in 1993 and on penalties after a 0-0 draw in 1991.
- The Nordic duo have played each other twice in the group stage, Norway running out 5-0 victors in 1997 (the competition record win until England beat Scotland 6-0) and Denmark prevailing 1-0 four years later.
- Neatly, their 12 competitive encounters have produced four wins each (not counting penalty shoot-outs) and four draws.
- Including friendlies, Norway have won 19 and Denmark 11 of their 43 match-ups. Norway lead 85-54 on goals scored.
- They last met in the 2015 Algarve Cup, Norway triumphing 5-2.
- Denmark's Theresa Nielsen is based in Norway with Vålerenga.
- Denmark trio Janni Arnth and Maja Kildemoes play alongside Norway's Kristine Minde at Linköping.
- Norway boss Martin Sjögren coached both Arnth and her Danish colleague Pernille Harder to the 2016 Swedish title with Linköping, before switching jobs.

One to watch: Ada Hegerberg (forward, Lyon)

What to watch out for: In men's football they talk of Germany as a 'tournament team' but in the female game Norway have a claim to that title. They have exceeded expectations at the last three EUROS, getting to two finals and the 2009 last four, despite not possessing a squad to match their 1995 world champions or 2000 Olympic gold medallists.

Just like four years ago, they have qualified only to then change coach – this time Roger Finjord has departed, the assistant to Even Pellerud up until summer 2015 citing the commute to Oslo from his home in northern Norway as the cause. Results had also been mixed but Finjord's successor Sjögren, fresh from winning the Swedish title with Linköping, will inherit an exciting forward line of UEFA Best Women's Player in Europe 2015/16 Hegerberg, fit-again Caroline Graham Hansen and a re-inspired Isabell Herlovsen.

What to watch out for: Their run to the 2013 semi-finals – beating France on penalties before falling to Norway by the same method – ended a long period of disappointments at big tournaments for Denmark (even if they did not win any of their five games in 90 minutes and needed the drawing of lots to pip Russia to the last eight as a best third-placed team). They also began 2017 qualifying slowly but were to come good, culminating in an impressive scalp of Sweden.

Having beaten Portugal 6-0, Russia 6-1 and Finland 5-0 this year, a team with the attacking resources of Pernille Harder, Nadia Nadim and Katrine Veje cannot be underestimated, with their hero goalkeeper of 2013 Stina Petersen still going strong.
